

# Swimming Pool Rules (revised 6/2010)

These rules are provided by the Summerfield Pool Committee. Observance of these rules will assure all pool users a safe and pleasant experience while enjoying this *NON-SMOKING* facility.

Dressing rooms and pool gates are kept locked at all times and can be opened with your Clubhouse key.

Guests *must* be registered *and accompanied* by a Summerfield Civic Association Member *at all times*. Each member is required to sign in at one of the two sign-in points and add the number of guests.

**The maximum number of guests** in the pool area at any one time is *four per household*. Host member must accompany guests, and is responsible for their conduct and safety.

Members and adult guests may use the pool at any time. Youth guests under 18 years of age may use the pool *only* during the following hours:

**11:00 AM to 1:00 PM**

**7:00 PM to 8:00 PM**

Youth guests are expected to be respectful of all others using the pool area or they will be asked to leave.

Oregon State Law requires safety ropes during youth swim hours. Anyone playing on the ropes will be asked to leave.

Safety devices that are worn by the swimmer are acceptable

***Diving is not allowed at all. Diving is not safe in this pool! (prohibited by State Law)***

## ***NOT allowed in the pool:***

Cut offs or street clothing (except t-shirts for sun protection)

Persons with a communicable disease.

Bandages of any kind.

Toys (except those provided by the Pool Committee), inner tubes, boards, snorkels, fins, etc.

Adults may use a flotation device (known as a "noodle") in the Summerfield pool during adult swimming hours only.

## ***NOT allowed in the pool enclosure area:***

Smoking, Food, Drinks, glass containers, or pets

Playing with Life Saving equipment

Running, scuffling, rough-housing, or cannon-balling

Children in diapers of any kind, including pool or swimming pool diapers, or children of diaper age.

All persons should take a cleansing shower before entering the pool. Chairs and lounges should be covered with a robe or towel when lotion or oil is used.

Residents younger than 55 must carry their SCA membership card and be prepared to show it if asked, otherwise they may be asked to leave.

The pool is *NOT* available for private parties.

The pool is closed for maintenance Tuesday mornings from 7:00 AM to 9:00 am. No one may be in the pool during that time.

Compliance with these few requirements assures a safe and enjoyable time for everyone at the pool. Have fun and enjoy!
